

2010 Turkey Week Striper Tournament

November 20th through 27th

Entry Fee & Entry Fee Payout

Entry fee is **\$150 per boat if received by Nov. 13th**, after that, the cost is **\$200 per boat**. No entries will be accepted after 6pm on November 20, 2010. Online registration & payment (including entry fee & calcuttas) available. See www.irba.us for details. There is a guaranteed payout of 50% of the entry monies. It will be split 50%, 30% and 20% for the first, second and third heaviest Striper. Trophies will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd & 3rd heaviest Striper.

Captain's Meeting

Will be held on **November 20th** from **3pm to 6pm at the Green Turtle in Lewes**. A representative from each boat **should** attend the meeting. It is the responsibility of the participants to fully understand the printed rules. Food and drinks will be served to tournament participants.

Tournament Dates

November 21st through 27th Boats may fish only **2 of the 7 days** of this tournament. **Boats must declare a fish day** by calling **xxx xxx xxxx** by 7:00 am on the fish day . Please leave boat name and tournament number. If you do not call, then your boat is considered **NOT** fishing for that day.

Fishing Hours

Boats may leave any port or ramp they wish within the tournament boundaries but not before 6am. No lines, teasers or bait of any kind may be put in the water until **7:00am**. All lines and teasers must be out of the water at **3:00pm**.

Boundary Limits

Boundary limit all legal waters **30 nautical miles** from Indian River sea buoy (Green Can).Your track for the days fishing must be left on your GPS until your fish are weighed. See rule 14.

Weigh-In Times

Weigh-in starts at **3:00pm**. No fish may be weighed prior to that time. Scales close at **5:00pm**. Any fish not available for weigh-in by 5:00pm for any reason other than the exception will not qualify. **Exception:** to accommodate anglers from Lewes and Ocean City, a tournament official will be stationed at the Lewes Harbour Marina and White Marlin marina from 3:00 to 5:00PM to tag eligible fish for transport **directly** to the tournament scales at Indian River Marina. **Time will be allowed to transport tagged fish from Lewes and Ocean City to Indian River.** All fish must be weighed or tagged directly from the tournament registered boat from which they were caught. Fish must be brought to the IRBA scale at the fish cleaning facility in Indian River Marina.. You may weigh 3 Stripers per day fished.

Additional Rules :

1. All fish must be caught by rod and reel only. In order to be eligible for awards, prizes & Calcutta's, fish must be caught legally by state & federal regulations..
2. Each boat must prominently display their tournament number while fishing.
3. In the event of a breakdown, you may use an alternate boat after getting permission from the tournament director. Your tournament number must be displayed on the alternate boat.
4. All fish eligible for awards & cash prizes may be subject to examination by tournament directors.
5. Protest committee will consist of tournament director & weigh master. The tournament committee shall have the right to rule and decide on any dispute. Their decision is final and binding in any matter.
6. Polygraph examination may be required of winning crews.
7. It shall be the responsibility of the participant to keep all eligible catches in suitable condition until weigh-in.
8. No fish may be placed in the walk in freezer at the fish cleaning facility before weigh in.
9. All boats must weigh their fish at the tournament scale located at the fish cleaning facility at Indian River Marina.
10. A representative from the boat must remain with the fish until the fish has been weighed on the tournament scale.
11. Fish must come directly off a registered boat at the weigh station. You may weigh 3 Stripers per day fished.
12. The crew members of each individual boat will be solely responsible for the decision as to which days to fish. The IRBA and it's sponsors assume no liability or responsibility for any damage or loss.
13. Only one day needs to be fished by one boat to make the tournament official and award prizes. The IRBA director has the right to cancel the tournament.
14. The days GPS track line must be available for tournament official review at the weigh in or tagging stations. Failure to comply with this rule will disqualify that days catch.

2010 Calcutta Info for Turkey Week Striper Tournament

CALCUTTA INFORMATION

After entering the Turkey Week Striper Tournament, boats may enter any or all of the seven added entry divisions of:

A. Heaviest fish

- A.1 \$50
- A.2 \$125

B. Combined weight for 3 heaviest fish caught during the two days of fishing*

- B.1 \$50
- B.2 \$125

For the two Calcutta's above:

- 1st place pays 50%
- 2nd place pays 30%
- 3rd place pays 20%

C. Heaviest fish takes all at \$125

D. Heaviest combination of 3 fish caught during the two days of fishing* takes all at \$125

E. Daily Calcutta ** \$100

* must be a total of three fish

** your entry in this Calcutta will only be added to the daily purse on the days you fish.

95% of all the Calcutta money will be awarded.

NOTE: You can only win money from a Calcutta that you entered.

In the event of a tie for a first place fish, the first and second place monies will be split. The third place monies will go to the next heaviest fish. In the event of a tie for a second place fish, the second and third place monies will be split. There will be no third place winner. In the event of a tie for third place, the third place monies will be split. For categories that have first, second and third place, if there are no second or third place fish, the first place fish takes all. If there is no third place fish, the first and second place fish split the third place money. If any of Calcutta B categories (1, 2) are not filled, that money will go to the heaviest fish in the corresponding Calcutta A categories (1, 2) that was entered in Calcutta B. If Calcutta D is not filled, that money will go to the heaviest fish in Calcutta C that was entered in Calcutta D. If Calcutta E is not filled when participating boats fish, a drawing will be held between participating boats with the money going to the winner
